Stanza

In poetry, a stanza (/ ? s t æ n z ? /; from Italian stanza, "room") is a grouped set of lines within a poem, usually set off from other stanzas by a blank line or indentation. Stanzas can have regular rhyme and metrical schemes, though stanzas are not strictly required to have either.
